5. We were given a bar graph showing different types of noise pollution in cities and rural areas in Australia.
6. We were given a table showing the actual population in three different cities in 1990 and the prediction of population growth up to the year 2000.
7. We were given two maps showing the changes in the riverside park between 2010 and 2015.
8. We were given a table showing the numbers of all postgraduates from university in total in five different countries, and separately the numbers for men/women who worked in 1999.

11. We received two pie charts with information about vehicle exports by a company in three years (1996, 2006 and 2016). We were asked to report the main features and compare/contrast where possible.

12. We were given pie charts showing the figures for electricity consumption in different sectors in Australia between 2007 and 2010. We had to summarize and describe the information.

13. We were given a bar chart to describe, showing the generation of wind energy in megawatts for four different countries from 1985 to 2000.

14. We were given three pie charts showing vehicle exports by a particular company. We had to summarize and compare all three categories: cars, motorcycles and trucks.

We were given two pie charts showing and comparing the difference between the proportion of children under 18 years old that play a musical instrument in 1996 and 2016. 17. We were given two maps showing an old museum and a renovated/new museum. We had to summarize and compare the changes.
18. Two bar charts were given. One was describing the percentage of men in 3 different age groups who were employed in 1984, 2001 and 2014. The other bar chart described the percentage of women, also in three age groups (same as men), who were employed in 1984, 2001 and 2014. We were asked to write a report describing and comparing the charts.
19. We were given a graph showing annual salaries for language-related jobs in five international cities.



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20. We were given a chart with figures describing new house construction starts between 1999 and 2002.

21. We were given a diagram showing the steps in the process of making cheese. We were asked to describe the diagram.
